Important Voter Information

What is a Primary Election?

A Primary Election is used by political parties to nominate a candidate to move on to the General Election. Florida is a closed primary state, meaning a voter must be registered with a political party to vote in that party's primary races.

You can change your party affiliation by submitting an updated <u>Voter</u> <u>Registration Application</u> at any time, but the change must be made 29 days before a Primary Election in order to be valid for that election.

If all candidates in a race have the same party affiliation and the winner will be unopposed in the General Election, anyone may vote in the primary for that race, regardless of party affiliation. This is known as a Universal Primary Contest. The primary is also used to narrow down the number of candidates in nonpartisan races (such as school board) and may include some amendments or

referenda. All voters, whether affiliated with a political party or not, vote on nonpartisan races and issues in the Primary Election.

Verify & Update Your Voter Information

Our Elections Office uses the signature we have on file to verify your identity on petitions, provisional ballots, and Vote-by-Mail ballots. Using the online application will update your voter record with the most recent signature from your Florida driver license or Florida ID card.
