9/11 Memorial Stair Climb and 5K Run & Walk



Attend the 6th Annual 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb and Inaugural 5K Walk & Run for charity on Sunday, Sept. 8, 2024! This event takes place at [515 N. Flagler Drive, West Palm Beach](#), at 9 a.m., and pays tribute to the lives lost on September 11, 2001.

The West Palm Beach Fire Department 9/11 Memorial Stair Climb is a solemn occasion to honor and remember the heroes and victims of the tragic events that unfolded on that fateful day. Participants will symbolically climb the equivalent of 110 stories, mirroring the harrowing ascent faced by first responders at the World Trade Center.

This year's 5K and 1-mile race will take participants on an out-and-back course down N. Flagler Drive along the iconic West Palm Beach waterfront. In addition to the stair climb and 5K, the event promises an array of activities for participants and spectators alike, including a friendly CrossFit competition.
