Important Voter Information

2024 GENERAL ELECTION

Voter Registration Deadline

Monday, October 7, 2024

Register to Vote or Update Your Voter Registration Record:

- Online at VotePalmBeach.gov or RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov. Please have your FL Driver License or ID available.
- In person at any of our four offices Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., or at other voter registration agencies.
- By mail. Forms are available in person at any of our offices or online at VotePalmBeach.gov. Mailed forms must be complete and postmarked by October 7, 2024.

Voters who are already registered are encouraged to verify and, if needed, update their voter registration. Check your registration information on the My Status page at VotePalmBeach.gov.

Our Elections Office uses the signatures we have on file to verify your identity on petitions, provisional ballots, and Vote-by-Mail ballots.

Signature Updates Can Be Made:

- Online at RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov. *Using the online application will update your voter record with the most recent signature from your Florida Driver License or Florida ID card.*
- By completing and returning a Florida voter registration application form to a voter registration agency or one of our offices. *Forms are available online at VotePalmBeach.gov and at any voter registration agency.*

Deadline to Request Vote-by-Mail

Monday, October 24, 2024, by 5:00 p.m.

If you want to Vote-by-Mail in the upcoming 2024 General Election and haven't requested a ballot since November 9, 2022, you must make a new request.

 - Cancel the appointment at any time.
 - Receive text notifications about your upcoming appointment.
 - Skip the line to vote quickly.
