1/2 Penny Still Needed

- Maintain over 30 million sq. ft. and \$9 billion dollars of buildings to avoid creating deteriorating facilities and maintenance backlog
- **Existing funding streams are not sufficient** to maintain current needs due to escalation of construction, materials, and maintenance costs
- There are **no other funding options available** for schools
- Due to legislative changes, **school districts receive 25% less** in capital revenue as compared to 2008

Facts About the ½ Penny for Education

- Oracle And Andrew Content of the second seco
- All Funds Stay Local: All funds stay in Palm Beach County and invests in our kids, classroom technology and school safety.
- Obes Not Raise Taxes: The ½ penny is a continuation of an existing sales tax for schools and will not raise taxes.
- **Tax Has a Cap:** The ¹/₂ penny is capped at the first \$5,000 of a single consumer purchase.
- Section Sectio
- **Tourists and Visitors Pay:** Tourists and visitors also pay the sales tax.
- **Expires in 10 years:** The ¹/₂ penny expires in 10 years and cannot be extended without voter approval.
- \bigcirc **Oversight:** Overseen by an independent committee of local citizens and experts.

PALM BEACH COUNTY SCHOOLS SECURITY, TECHNOLOGY, FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE ONE-HALF CENT SALES SURTAX

To support educational opportunities for students by upgrading and enhancing safety and security of schools; classroom technology and equipment, school buildings and facilities, and school buses, for Palm Beach County traditional public and charter public schools; shall the School Board levy a one-half cent sales surtax beginning January 1, 2026 and, by law, automatically ending December 31, 2035, with oversight of all funds by an independent committee of citizens and experts?
