- Mail in Ballots
 - Under current Florida Laws, voters who choose to vote by mail must renew their Vote-By-Mail request for each election cycle, which occurs every two years after the General Election. If you want to receive a Vote-By-Mail Ballot for the 2025 elections, you will need to complete a new Vote-By-Mail request.

 Armen discussed storm preparation including tornados such as the do's & don'ts, various levels and there is NO TIME/NO NOTICE. Encourages signing up for ALERTPBC, prep should be the same as hurricane prep and you must take responsibility/ownership as a disaster can happen anytime.

David Reyes, PBG Community Services Administrator

• David discussed storm preparation including tornados such as pre storm events, importance of creating a safe area, document and store documents in a safe place, if your house was destroyed where would you go.
